#### ITINERARY WITH STAY IN LISBON

##### Day 1 (Monday) LISBON

Arrival at the airport. Assistance and transfer to the hotel. Accommodation. Rest of the day free.

##### Day 2 (Tuesday) LISBON

Breakfast and accommodation. In the morning, panoramic sightseeing takes you to the Alfama Quarter. Belem Tower and Jeronimo's Monastery. Afternoon by yourself to enjoy the city or take an optional excursion to the beautiful towns of Sintra, Cascais and Estoril.

#### ITINERARY FOR BOTH VERSIONS

**Day 3/1 (Wednesday) LISBON - CÁCERES - SEVILLE**  
Breakfast and departure at the specified time for participants with stay in Lisbon (18 days).  
Tnp starts for participants without stay in Lisbon (15 days). Departure from the Hotel Roma, Av. de Roma 33, at 8:00 am.

Departure to the Spanish border and then down to Cáceres, World Heritage city. During the visit you will see the Plaza Mayor and the old town with its medieval quarter. Then continue to Seville. Overnight.

##### Day 4/2 (Thursday) SEVILLE

Breakfast and accommodation. In the morning, during the panoramic tour you will see University, Maria Luisa Park, America Square, the magnificent Pavilions of the 1929 Ibero-American Exposition, the Gardens of Murillo, and then, immediately begin a walking tour of the Santa Cruz Quarter arriving at two World Heritage monuments: the Alcázar and the Cathedral (visit inside) with the Giralda. Afternoon at leisure to explore the city and its traditional quarters.

##### Day 5/3 (Friday) SEVILLE - RONDA - COSTA DEL SOL

Breakfast and departure. We will take the scenic Route of the White Villages to reach Ronda, one of the oldest cities in Spain. Free time to admire the most important monuments such as the Plaza de Toros (Bullring), symbol and soul of the city, and the Puente Nuevo (New Bridge), from where we enjoy spectacular views. In the afternoon, drive to the world famous Costa del Sol. Dinner and overnight.

##### Day 6/4 (Saturday) COSTA DEL SOL

Breakfast, dinner and overnight. Day free in this world famous tourist destination, surrounded by mountains and the Mediterranean sea. You can enjoy the beaches, one of the best in Europe.

##### Day 7/5 (Sunday) C. SOL - ALGECIRAS/TARIFA - TANGIER-RABAT

Breakfast and then, take the scenic route along the Costa del Sol to reach Algeciras / Tarifa, where we will board the Straits of Gibraltar crossing ferry towards Tangier. Sightseeing tour visiting the Royal Palace, the Mohammed V Mausoleum, the Hassan Tower and the Fortress or the Kasbah of the Udayas. Dinner and overnight.

##### Day 8/6 (Monday) RABAT-CASABLANCA-MARRAKESH

Breakfast and head to Casablanca, the economic, industrial and financial capital, which represents the development and modernity, and is the first port of the country. Sightseeing tour of this cosmopolitan and fabulous city. After the visit, you will have free time to visit the stunning Hassan II Mosque, the third largest in the world. Continue to Marrakesh. Dinner and overnight.

##### Day 9/7 (Tuesday) MARRAKESH

Breakfast, lunch and overnight. In the morning, visit the imperial city, the Pearl of the South and enjoy the incredible atmosphere in Djemaa el Fna Square, Cultural Heritage of Humanity, where musicians, snake charmers, acrobats and fortune tellers entertain you. Spend the afternoon at leisure to continue exploring the city.

##### Day 10/8 (Wednesday) MARRAKESH - MEKNES - FEZ

Breakfast and departure to Meknes, Cultural Heritage of Humanity, and the capital of the kingdom in the time of Sultan Moulay Ismail, founder of the Alawite dynasty. Sightseeing tour to admire the 'Bab el-Mansour' Gate, the largest and most beautiful in North Africa; Royal Stables and the Mausoleum of Moulay Ismail. Continue to Fez. Dinner and overnight.

##### Day 11/9 (Thursday) FEZ

Breakfast, lunch and overnight. In the morning, panoramic tour of the city, home to the oldest university in the world. We will visit the Jewish quarter and the Christian quarter, the seven gates of the Royal Palace and the Great Medina of Fez, the world's largest pedestrian area and World Heritage Site, where we visit a 14th century madrasa (Koranic school). Afternoon at leisure.

##### Day 12/10 (Friday) FEZ - TANGIER-TARIFA/ALGECIRAS - COSTA DEL SOL

Breakfast then head for Tangier and cross back over the Straits of Gibraltar heading for Tarifa / Algeciras. Disembark and take the scenic route along the Costa del Sol. Dinner and overnight.

##### Day 13/11 (Saturday) COSTA DEL SOL - GRANADA

Breakfast and free time. Mid-morning departure to Granada which is located at the foot of the Sierra Nevada mountains. Visit the remarkable Alhambra, a palace and fortress complex declared a World Heritage Site, with its wonderful Nasrid Palaces and the gardens of the Generalife. Overnight.

##### Day 14/12 (Sunday) GRANADA - TOLEDO - MADRID

Breakfast and drive to Toledo. Take a tour of this monumental city, a World Heritage Site. Panoramic sightseeing and then a walking tour of the old town, visiting the Cathedral (inside visit), Church of Santo Tomé, which houses the painting widely regarded as a masterpiece of El Greco, 'The Burial of Count Orgaz', and then in the old Jewish Quarter, you will see the Synagogue of Santa Maria la Blanca. In the afternoon, departure to Madrid. Overnight.

##### Day 15/13 (Monday) MADRID

Breakfast and accommodation. In the morning, panoramic sightseeing: Plaza de España, Ciudad Universitaria (University City), Parque del Oeste, Casa de Campo, Barrio de la Moreña, Plaza de Oriente (Oriente Square), Plaza Mayor, Puerta del Sol, Neptuno, Atocha, Puerta de Alcalá, the stately Retiro Park, Las Ventas Bullring, Plaza de Colón, Paseo de la Castellana, Santiago Bernabeu Stadium, Cibeles Square and Gran Vía. Afternoon at leisure to explore the city.

##### Day 16/14 (Tuesday) MADRID

Breakfast and accommodation. Day at leisure to stroll around town or explore the surrounding areas like El Escorial, Ávila and Segovia, or attend one of their musical and theatrical performances.

##### Day 17/15 (Wednesday) MADRID

Breakfast and END OF TOUR.
