TOUR STARTS: MADRID

THURSDAY (April 11 to October 17, 2013)

MADRID - CANTABRICO

Day 1 (Thursday) MADRID

Arrival at the Barajas airport. Assistance and transfer to the hotel. Accommodation. Rest of the day free.

Day 2 (Friday) MADRID

Breakfast and accommodation. In the morning, panoramic sightseeing: Plaza de España, Ciudad Universitaria (University City), Parque del Oeste, Casa de Campo, Barrio de la Moreria, Plaza de Oriente (Oriente Square), Plaza Mayor, Puerta del Sol, Neptuno, Atocha, Puerta de Alcalá, the stately Retiro Park, Las Ventas Bullring, Plaza de Colon, Paseo de la Castellana, Santiago Bernabeu Stadium, Cibeles Square and Gran Via. Afternoon at leisure to explore the city or you may like to join an optional excursion to Toledo.

Day 3 (Saturday) MADRID - ZARAGOZA - SAN SEBASTIAN

Breakfast. Departure and head for Zaragoza. Free time to visit the Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar, patroness of the Hispanic World and visit the old town. In the afternoon, departure to San Sebastian, one of the most famous tourist destinations in Spain, known worldwide for its International Film Festival. Panoramic sightseeing: the landscape of this bourgeois and French-style city is dominated by the Bay and the Playa de La Concha (La Concha beach). Overnight.

Day 4 (Sunday) SAN SEBASTIAN - BILBAO - CASTRO URDIALES - SANTANDER

Breakfast and departure. Ascent Monte Igueldo, from where you can enjoy magnificent views of the town and bay. Continue to Bilbao, for a panoramic tour and free time on the esplanade of the Guggenheim Museum to admire this work of modern architecture. We continue to Castro Urdiales, typical fishing village where we will have free time. Departure to Santander, a port city located between the sea and the mountains that has many beaches, such as El Sardinero, one of the most popular. Free time to stroll through this elegant city. Overnight.

Day 5 (Monday) SANTANDER - SANTILLANA - COVADONGA - OVIEDO

Breakfast. Departure to Santillana, one of the towns of most artistic and historical value in Spain, which shelters architectural treasures such as the Collegiate Church of Santa Juliana, the most important Romanesque jewel in Cantabria. Continue to Covadonga, where we will have free time to visit the shrine and the cave with the image of the Virgin. In the afternoon, drive to Oviedo. In the afternoon departure to Oviedo, built on a range of hills at the foot of Naranjo and noted for its beautiful streets, many of them pedestrian. Its monuments are World Heritage Sites, and among them highlights the Cathedral, one of the most important works of Gothic Asturian. Overnight.

Day 6 (Tuesday) OVIEDO - GIJON - CUDILLERO - LUGO

Breakfast. Departure to Gijón to make a panoramic tour and then, continue to reach Cudillero, a quaint fishing village. In the afternoon departure to Lugo, which still preserves vestiges of its Roman past, as its Walls, which has a perimeter of 2266 meters in circumference and are the only ones declared a World Heritage Site. Overnight.

Day 7 (Wednesday) LUGO - ASTORGA - MADRID

Breakfast. Departure to Astorga where we make a short stop and have free time to visit the famous Episcopal Palace, designed by Gaudi. Continue by Medina del Campo to reach Madrid.

Day 8 (Thursday) MADRID

Breakfast. END OF TOUR.

Day 7 (Wednesday) LUGO - A CORUÑA

Breakfast and departure to A Coruña. Panoramic sightseeing: you will see the Paseo de la Marina and its beautiful houses with glazed galleries, the Maria Pita Square and make a stop at the Tower of Hercules, the world's oldest lighthouse still in operation and a World Heritage Site, where you can contemplate a breathtaking view over the sea. Afternoon at leisure. Perhaps you may like to join an optional excursion to the Rias Altas. Overnight.

Day 8 (Thursday) A CORUÑA - SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

Breakfast. Departure to Santiago, whose old town is a World Heritage Site and one of the most important monumental complexes in Spain, Christian pilgrimage centre and end of the "Camino de Santiago" route, originally built by the Roman Empire. City tour visiting the Obradoiro Square and the Cathedral dedicated to St. James the Greater. Afternoon at leisure to continue visiting this city with its university and its young atmosphere. Overnight.

Day 9 (Friday) SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA - RIAS BAJAS - LA TOJA - VIGO

Breakfast. Drive to the most quaint area of the Galician Rias Bajas as you journey through splendid landscapes to reach the island of La Toja, universally known for its spa. Time at leisure and continue along the Arosa and Pontevedra estuaries to reach Vigo, located in the middle of the estuary to which it gives its name, the southernmost of the Rias Bajas and certainly the most beautiful, with its very attractive beaches. Overnight.

Day 10 (Saturday) VIGO - SALAMANCA - MADRID

Breakfast. Departure by the "Via de la Plata" road to reach Salamanca. Free time in this quintessential college town, of great artistic value: the Plaza Mayor, Casa de las Conchas, the New Cathedral, the Old Cathedral and the University are among the many attractions of this city whose historic centre is declared World Heritage Site. Continue to Villacastin and Guadarrama to reach Madrid. Overnight.

Day 11 (Sunday) MADRID

Breakfast. END OF TOUR.
